As readers, we will have daily Phonic lessons using the Read, write, inc. scheme. The children will learn new sounds daily and read stories to match their reading ability.

Please continue to support the children by listening to them read at home and recording this in their reading record at least five times a week.



Writing

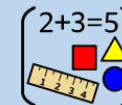
As writers, we will be following Read Write inc phonics to write about themes and ideas from our story books. We will write simple sentences using capital letters, full stops, neat handwriting and finger spaces. We will ensure our spellings match our phonic ability and we will transfer this to our writing. We will focus on spelling the common exception words appropriate for their year group.



Maths

As mathematicians, we will be developing our understanding of:

- Recognising and forming numbers to 10
- Comparing quantities using the vocabulary of more than, less than and equal to
- Counting, recognising and representing numbers within 100
- Solving calculations within 20



RE & PSHE

In RE, this term we will be exploring the question: Who is Muslim and how do they live?

In PSHE, we will be exploring the topics:

Emotions: How do I feel today?
Relationships: Who is in my family?

PE/ Sport

As part of our PE curriculum, we will be taking part in a variety of team, rules-based games as well as practicing individual skills.



Geography

As geographers, we will be using lots of key skills such as mapping and observations to undertake a costal study. We will consider environmental impacts and changes to the local area over time.



Science
