

Reading

We are teaching Reading through routines such as partner reading and 'My turn, Your turn' to model reading fluently.

In our Whole class reading sessions, we will study and then some shorter text excerpts to build fluency and comprehension.

Reading at home daily to an adult will help your child to excel in all areas of school life.

Writing

As writers, we are developing our skills correcting our sentences with capital letters, correct punctuation and using powerful language. We will be basing our writing on narrative texts: The Friendship Bench and Marshmallows.

We will also be completing a non-chronological report based on the text Singapore and a social media post text called Christmas Dessert.



Maths

As mathematicians we will develop our understanding of:

- Place Value
- Addition and subtraction
- Shape

RE

In RE, we will be looking into the big questions:

1. What do Christians learn from the Creation story?
2. How do festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim?

To learn about world views, we will be looking at how people flourish together. How can we develop spiritually to be able to understand others and our place in the world?

Curriculum Overview Autumn Term 2026-27

PSHE

In Personal, Spiritual and Health development, we are focussing on *Emotions* and *Media Influence*. Our school values of RESPECT and FRIENDSHIP will be central to our personal development and how we treat others in our community.

PE

This term, we will be focussed on our athletics skills of running, jumping and reaction times. We will also focus on sequencing and transitions in gymnastics.



Science

In Science, we will explore the unit: Nurturing Nature.
Within this we will:

- Recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways.
- Explore and use classification keys to help group.
- Identify and name a variety of living things in the environment.
- Recognise that environments can change and this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

Geography

As Geographers, we will be studying the key physical geographical features of local rivers and mountains.

History

As Historians, we will study the Ancient Egyptians and exploring the Big Question: What was life like for the Ancient Egyptians?

Art/ Design Technology

In Art we will be learning about Abstract art with a focus on the artist Arshile Gorky. We will design and make our own inspired work based on our observations.

In DT we will be exploring simple electrical circuits and designing and making a circuit with a switch.

Music

In music we will be exploring pulse, rhythm and pitch and then build on these skills to 'Play in an orchestra'.

Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about computing systems and networks and technology around us, as well as creating media through digital painting.

French

We will be learning introductions and describing where you live as well as talking about which subjects you like.
