


## Reading

We are teaching Reading through routines such as partner reading and 'My turn, Your turn' to model reading fluently.

Most children are now off the Read Write Inc phonics programme and all are accessing whole class reading this term. In our Whole class reading sessions, we will study 'Paddington Helps Out' and then some poetry examples.

## RE

In RE, we will be looking into the big questions:

Mrs Midwinter will be providing forest school sessions in Spring 2 on a Friday (SPR 1 TBC).



## Art/ Design Technology

## Writing

As writers, we are developing our skills as proof readers, correcting our sentences with capital letters, punctuation and using powerful language. We will be studying a non-chronological report on Earthquakes, instructions on How to Make a Bird Feeder and then we will study 'A Crow's Tale' by Naomi Howarth.



## Maths

As mathematicians we will develop our understanding of:

- Multiplication + division
- Recognising equal groups
- Using arrays
- Dividing by 2,5 and 10 (Year 2)
- Multiplying and dividing by 3,4 and 8 (Year 3)

## Science

In Science, we will explore **SUSTAINABILITY** with deforestation and its impact on soil erosion. We will be developing our knowledge of 'growth for the future' in this unit of learning. Following this, our Science will be based on how a sailboat functions and sustainability of materials.

## History

As Historians, we will be learning about great **EXPLORERS** such as Sir Ernest Shackleton & Sir Ranulph Fiennes.

## Geography

As Geographers, we will be learning about **EARTHQUAKES & VOLCANOES** - *What are the key aspects of the physical geography of volcanoes and earthquakes?*

## Computing

In Computing, we will be learning how to research using a Chrombook safely. We will also be starting to learn programming through sequencing sounds on the 'Teach Computing' scheme of learning.
