In these units we will understand how to keep ourselves safe on devices and in society. We will also be looking at self-image and perceptions, online pressures, how our bodies cha</p>
<p>Geography</p> <p>As geographers, we will explore trade and trading and how this can affect our economy. We will gain an understanding as to how countries trade, why trading is necessary and ethical trading. Within this unit we will use our skills of map work, data analysis and researching.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>As scientists, we will explore the body and gain an understanding as to how the body functions looking at the heart, the circulatory system as well as gain an understanding of the importance of a good diet, exercise and medicines and how this can affect our bodies.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>We will be exploring what discoveries were made in the early Islamic civilisations. Pupils will be learning differences between countries and cultures, the importance of the Islamic empire, new inventions developed in Baghdad and the impact on the rest of the world. They will be developing key enquiry skills using different resources.</p>
<p>Art/DT</p> <p>As artists this term, we will be exploring artwork of Louise Nevelson. Gaining inspiration from this artist we will design and create our own sculpture using her style as inspiration.</p> <p>We will also be making our own pizzas as part of our design and technology in cooking.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>As digital citizens, the children will be learning how to use vector diagrams to create a picture. They will learn how to use the tools, build the pictures, rotate the pictures and have a go at evaluating their design.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>As musicians, the children will be developing their singing chords, rhythm, tone and pitch. Children will be learning partner songs and round songs – singing different verses at the same time. We will be exploring different types of music from around the globe.</p>
<p>PE/ Sport</p> <p>In PE, we will be preparing for Sports Day and begin our training in athletics, throwing, jumping and shuttle relays this term. Sports day will be held on the last day of term. Next half term there will be a focus on net and raquet sports. After school clubs will commence 5th May.</p>
