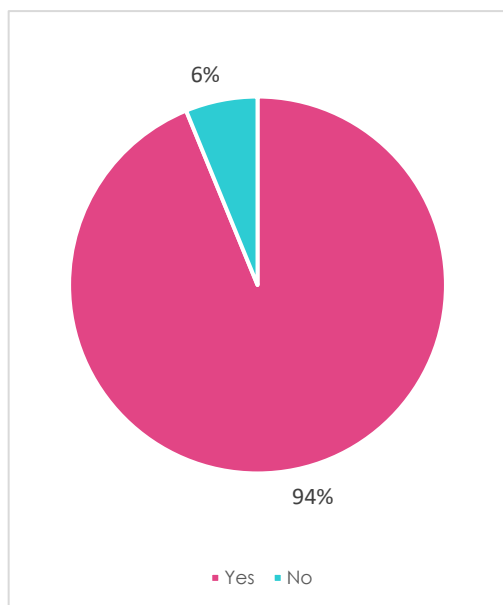
Marhamchurch C of E Academy

“I am proud of trying everything to be as good as I can.”

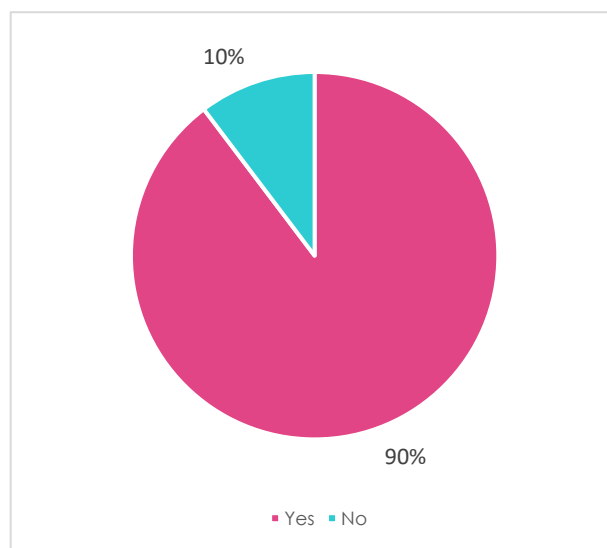
I am proud to attend my school

(2023-24 93%)

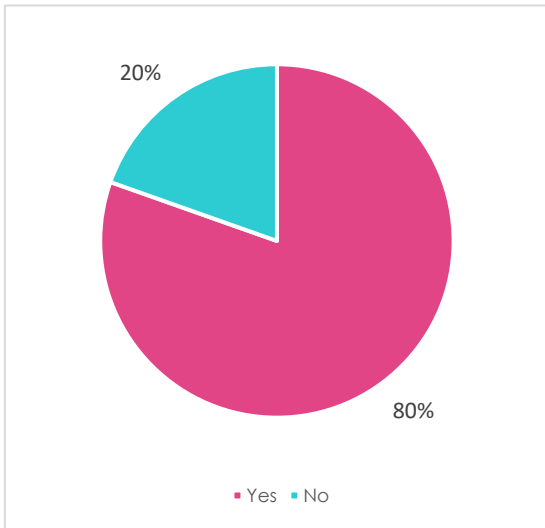
I feel listened to and have a voice in my class and my school community?

Do the school values help you to understand how to live together as a school



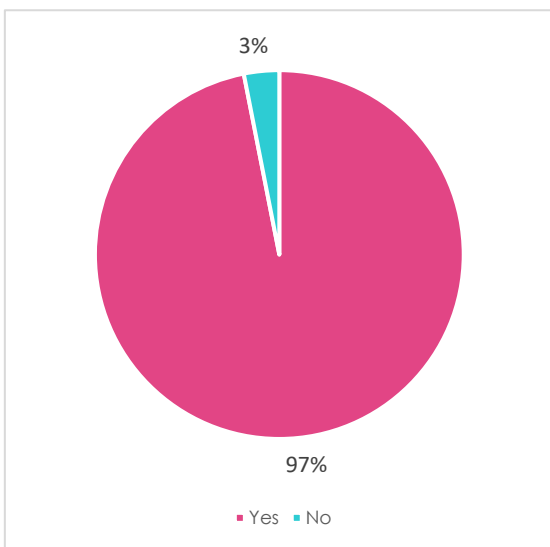
80% of children think the school's values help us to understand how to live better together.

Our Values Champions help to bring our school values to life.

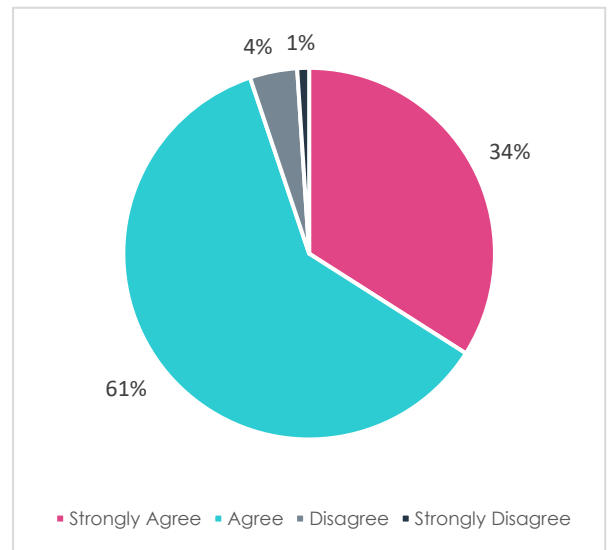
Does your teacher help you when you find things hard?



An overwhelming 97% agree that their teacher is helpful when they find learning hard. This reflects our feedback policy and Trust core offers.

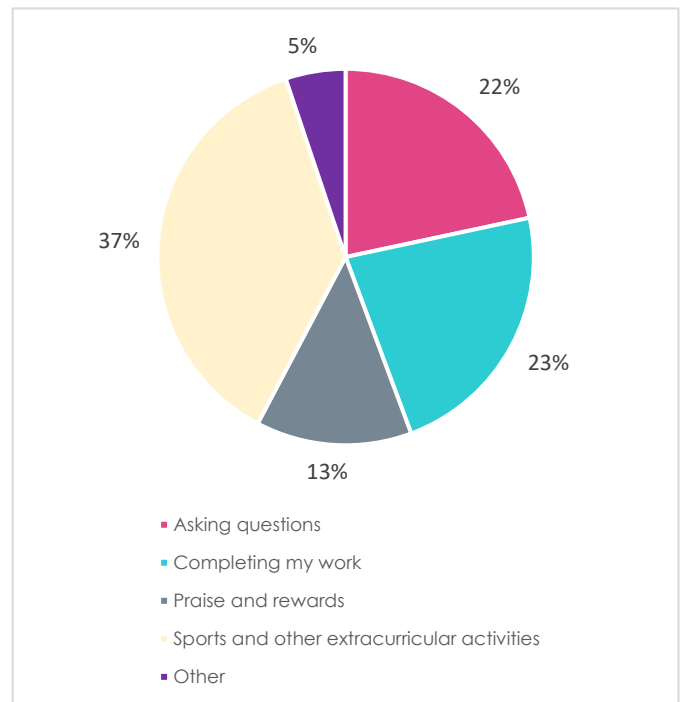
“Our Golden Rules and school values helps us to live well in our school.”

What are you proud of achieving in class / school this year?

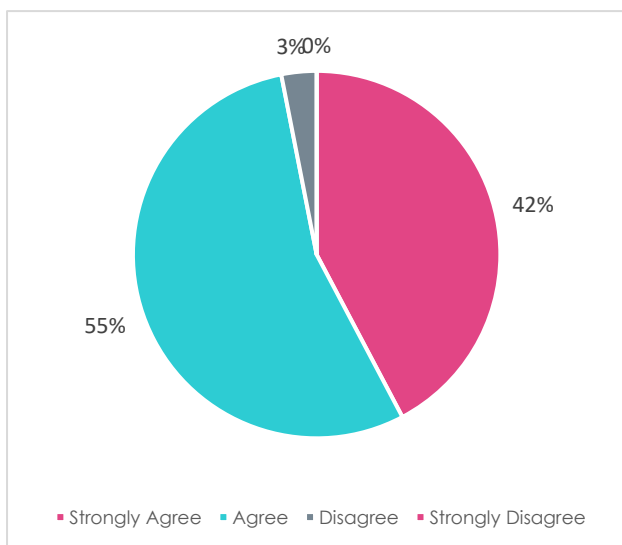
“Asking questions to help me to understand.”

Given a chance, what is the one change that you would like to see in your school or class?

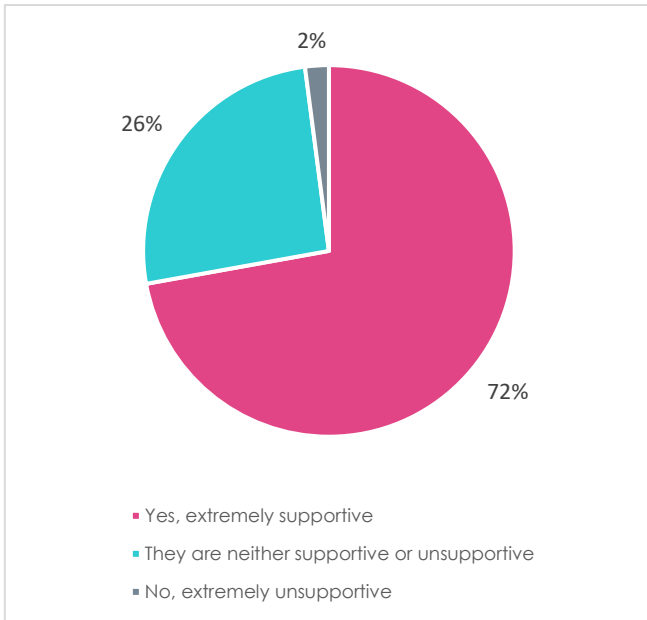
“More practical activities in all learning.”

“Break in the afternoon as well.”

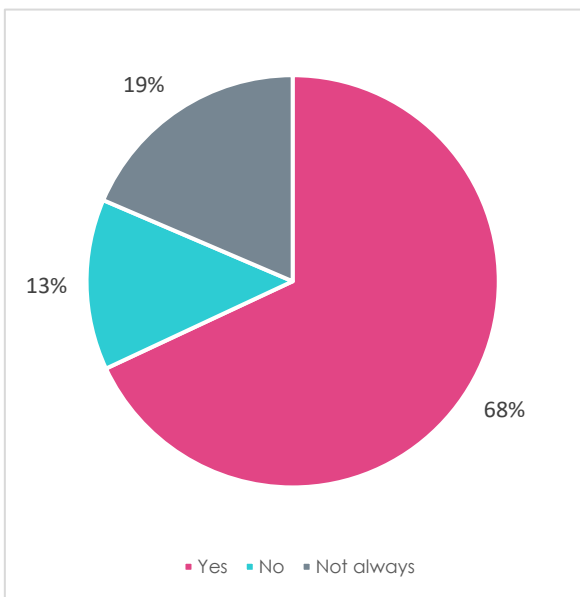
“I would change the calm corner and the reading corner to be a bit bigger.”



Do you have supportive classmates?

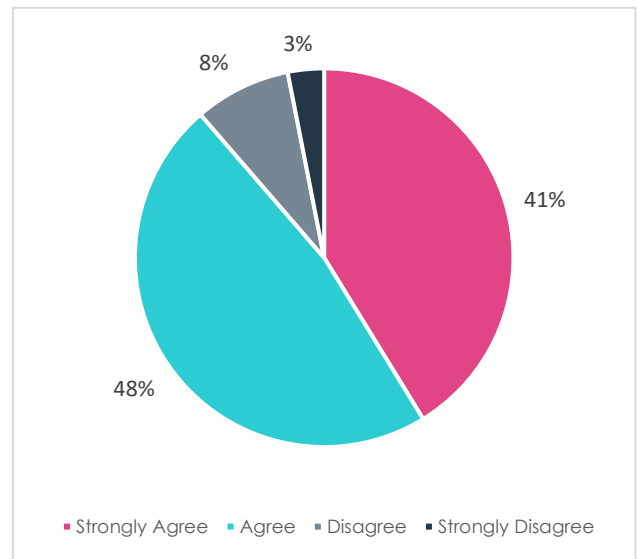


Do you think that the school provides you with enough sports / musical opportunities?



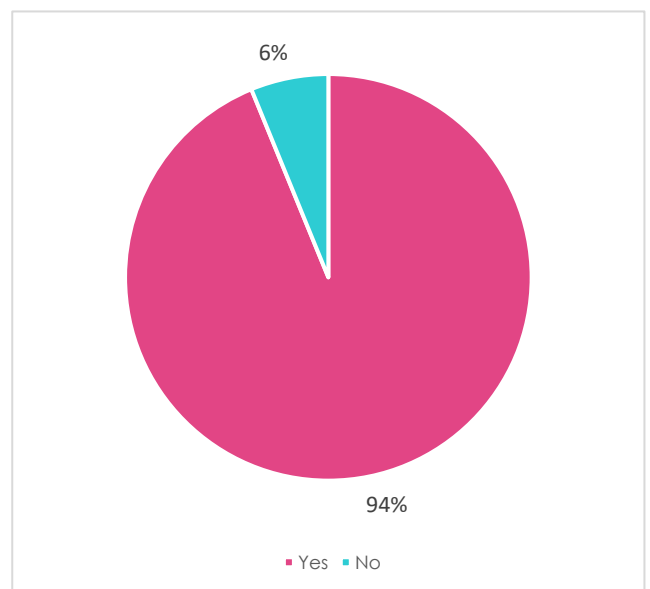

In my class there are clear expectations for behaviour and it's fair



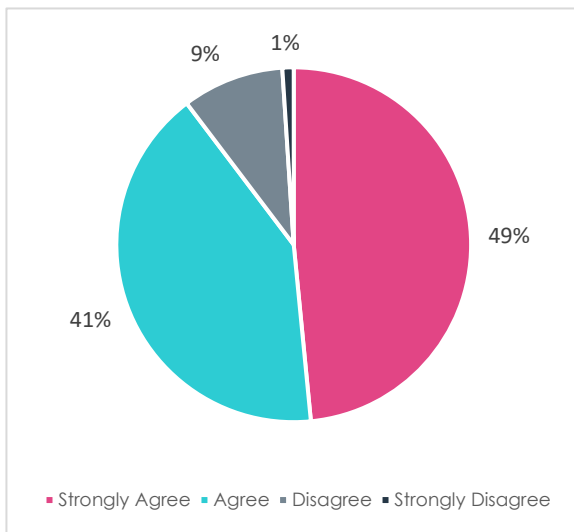
89% agree that there are clear expectations and that the school is fair. This is an increase of 19% from the previous year.
